- Please swipe your membership card at the front desk every time you enter the facility.
- All individuals using the facility or grounds are expected to follow all YMCA policies and procedures and to conduct themselves appropriately. Physical or verbal abuse, sexual innuendo or display, or offensive behavior of any kind is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- It is illegal to carry a firearm or deadly weapon anywhere on YMCA property.
- Children ages 6 and under are to be supervised at all times by a parent or responsible adult (16 years or older), unless participating in a staff supervised program.
- You are held responsible for any loss or damage to YMCA facility and will be held personally and financially liable.
- Please wear proper gym, swim and workout attire. No flip flops, slides, jeans, cut-off shirts or shirts that show midriff are allowed in the Wellness Center or Free Weight area.
- Please store your personal belongings in a locked locker (bring your own lock). We also rent lockers for \$50.00/year. The YMCA is not responsible for any items stolen from the facility or grounds.
- Please don't leave your keys on the lockers in the locker rooms. Items must be removed daily.
- The YMCA prohibits and will not tolerate any form of bullying or sexual harassment from any member. This includes verbal, non-verbal or physical harassment and assault. The YMCA is committed to provide a safe and enjoyable environment.
- While the Ashland Family YMCA is a non-profit organization, it is still a private entity. Membership is a privilege not a right. We reserve the right at any time to revoke your membership for any reason. All matters will be handled through the CEO and the board president.
