It is the intent of the Ashland YMCA to provide a safe and friendly environment for all members, volunteers, and staff. We strive to have our members and staff exemplify an attitude of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Please join us as we strive to strengthen the foundations of this community by supporting youth development, promoting healthy living and committing to our social responsibility.

- Please sign in when you enter the facility.
- All individuals using the facility or grounds are expected to follow all YMCA policies and procedures and to conduct themselves appropriately. Physical or verbal abuse, sexual innuendo or display, or offensive behavior of any kind is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- It is illegal to carry a firearm, deadly weapon, or dangerous ordnance anywhere on YMCA property.
- Children ages 6 and under are to be supervised at all times by a parent or responsible adult (16 years or older), unless participating in a staff supervised program.
- You are held responsible for any loss or damage to YMCA facility and will be held personally and financially liable.
- Please wear proper gym, swim and workout attire. No flip flops, slides, jeans, cut-off shirts or shirts that show midriff are allowed in the Wellness Center or Free Weight area.
- Please store your personal belongings in a locked locker (bring your own lock) or you can purchase one at the front desk. We also rent lockers for \$50.00/year. The YMCA is not responsible for any items stolen from the facility or grounds.
- Please don't leave your locks on the lockers in the locker rooms. Items must be removed daily.
- YMCA has the right to determine if any conduct or language is inconsistent with the mission of the YMCA and to act accordingly.
- The YMCA prohibits and will not tolerate any form of bullying or sexual harassment from any member. This includes verbal, non-verbal or physical harassment and assault. The YMCA is committed to provide a safe and enjoyable environment.
- Failure to follow the above Rules & Code of Conduct will be considered in violation of the "Member Behavior Code" and may result in permanent or temporary suspension of membership privileges.
